



Photography Policy

Portsmouth & Southsea Fencing club (PSFC) may, as stated in the Privacy policy, use photographs and video footage for training/coaching or promotional purposes. The images may be posted on the club's social media page and the website. No personal details other than the fencers name and the name of the club will accompany published images.

It is PSFC's aim to ensure the images/video taken are used only for the appropriate purposes for which it was taken. Should any member or parent/carer become aware that club images/footage are not being used in this way please inform the club immediately.

Adult members and Parents/Carers of junior members may decide to 'opt out' when completing the membership form. It is possible to opt in or out at any time, not just at the time of completing the membership form. Please inform the Welfare Officer or Chair of the PSFC Committee.

Parents/Carers may take photographs of their children for personal use providing no other children at the club are identifiable within the photographs. However, this is at the discretion of the Coach to ensure the fencing session is not disrupted. Anyone found taking images without consent and photographing children other than their own will be asked to delete the images.

Flash photography is not to be used in line with British Fencing guidelines
